To qualify for Gift Aid, you must pay an amount of UK Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your donations in the appropriate tax year (currently 25p for each £1 given)*.

Notes:

1. You can cancel this Declaration at any time by notifying the charity (Friends of Florendine).
2. If your circumstances change and you no longer pay enough income or capital gains tax to cover the amount claimed by the charity, you should cancel your declaration.
3. If you pay tax at the higher rate, you can claim further tax relief via your Self Assessment tax return. (currently 25p for each pound you give)**
4. Please notify the charity if you change your name or address.

* Gift Aid is linked to basic rate tax. Basic rate tax is currently 20%, which allows charities to reclaim 25 pence on the pound.

** Higher rate taxpayers can claim back the difference between basic rate and higher rate tax, via their self assessment tax return.
